In the fall of 2015, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) posted a statement on its website concerning the litigation over the new "Waters of the U.S." (WOTUS) rule, acknowledging

that the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit has temporarily blocked EPA and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) from implementing the new rule, pending further action of the court. The statement confirms that the agencies are back to using the prior regulatory definition of WOTUS and applicable guidance (status quo as it existed before the new rule) in
